

Washington, DC is the capital city of the USA but doesn't belong to a state.

The USA is split into 50 different areas called states. Each state has its own capital city along with its own laws and government. However, they are still part of the federal government of the United States.

Climate zones

The USA has a diverse climate but can be defined by three main types.

Arid = Hot and dry all year. 2 seasons. Cold during winter nights

Monument Valley (Arid)



Tropical = Warm and wet all year.

Honolulu (Tropical)



Temperate = Rainfall all year. 4 seasons. Mild winters and summers.

Seattle (Temperate)
